The Rugby Football Union, in association with its partners, is looking to appoint a Special Needs Community Rugby Coach in Hampshire.

Responsibilities:

- To deliver rugby coaching to young people with Special Needs in local schools, clubs and community groups as directed by the Rugby Development Officer (RDO) and Management Group.
- To introduce leadership skills to young people and provide ongoing support and sustainability by delivering teacher and coach education.
- To take a professional approach in the planning, preparation and organisation of coaching sessions.
- To maintain a comprehensive schedule of coaching as established and administered by the RDO and Management Group.

Qualifications:

Must be educated to a minimum of 'GCSE' standard preferably with at least five GCSEs at grade C or above. Will have experience of coaching children and young people. Experience of working with young people with Special Needs whilst being advantageous is not necessary. Preferred candidates should also hold:

- An RFU coaching qualification (minimum Level 2).
- A National Foundation Referees Certificate Part 1 or Entry Level Referee Award.
- A recognised First Aid qualification.
- Current Driving Licence

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The post involves working flexible hours as sessions will take place during the day as well as evenings and weekends.

Ideally the successful candidate should have a good knowledge and understanding of the game and the operation of junior rugby in Hampshire. They should be keen to develop a career in the sports/leisure industry.

Sport England is managing the Community Sports Coach Scheme with the support of the Department for Culture, Media and Sport and other partners, based on the key recommendations of the Coaching Task Force.
